

Code of Conduct for Supplier

1. Introduction

Shanghai United Imaging Healthcare Co., Ltd., and its subsidiaries and affiliates (collectively, “UIH” or “We”) highly value our cooperation with suppliers and regard integrity and legality as the foundation of our cooperation with suppliers (collective, “supplier”). UIH hopes that all supplier will uphold the principle of integrity, adhere to business ethics, comply with legal regulations, and create a clean business environment and maintain good business order with UIH. For this purpose, we formulate this Code of Conduct for Supplier (the “Code”).

2. Scope of Application

This Code applies to supplier of UIH. Supplier shall ensure that their directors, senior executives, managers, employees, dispatched personnel, temporary workers, consultants, etc. (collectively, “Supplier Personnel”), comply with the requirements of this Code when representing the supplier or participating in UIH's business-related activities.

3. Prohibition of Bribery

Supplier shall not give or promise to give any form of benefit to any government department, enterprise, public institution, or social organization for the purpose of obtaining or maintaining business opportunities/business benefits or influencing transactions (collectively, “business benefit purposes”).

UIH and its affiliated enterprises fall within the aforementioned scope of “enterprise”.

If a supplier represents UIH or carries out activities for the benefit of UIH, the supplier shall not give or promise to give any form of benefit to any government department, enterprise, public institution, or social organization.

Supplier shall not give or promise to give any form of benefit to any unit or individual entrusted by UIH to handle related affairs for business benefit purposes.

Supplier shall not give or promise to give any form of benefit to any unit or individual who can influence UIH based on their authority or influence for business benefit purposes.

Supplier shall not give kickbacks to UIH off the books.

Supplier and Supplier Personnel shall not solicit or accept bribes from any unit or individual. Supplier shall take effective measures to prevent Supplier Personnel from accepting bribes.

The aforementioned "benefit" include but not limited to:

- Cash
- Discounts
- Kickbacks
- Use of materials, equipment, software or devices
- Favors
- Gifts
- Travel and accommodation
- Research donations

- Sponsorships
- Contracts
- Loans
- Air tickets, Entertainment
- Employment/Hiring

4. Conflict of Interest

In the event of the following conflicts of interest, the supplier shall disclose to UIH in a timely, complete, and truthful manner before cooperating with UIH or after the situation arises:

- 1) There is a kinship between the supplier's personnel and UIH's personnel;
- 2) The supplier provides any form of benefit to any UIH personnel;
- 3) The supplier has any form of economic dealings with any UIH personnel;
- 4) The supplier or its affiliated companies are invested by any UIH personnel (whether directly or indirectly, openly or anonymously, in whole or in part);
- 5) Commercial entities (outside of UIH) invested, operated, or serviced by UIH personnel are invested by the supplier, its affiliated companies, or its personnel (whether directly or indirectly, openly or anonymously, in whole or in part);
- 6) The supplier or its affiliated companies or its personnel operate UIH's competitive products or engage in UIH's competitive business.

5. Fair Competition

In providing goods or services and participating in the entire process of UIH's procurement activities, the supplier shall adhere to business ethics and be honest and upright. Unfair and unreasonable trading conditions shall not be set, and forced trading shall not be allowed. The supplier shall not seek to gain commercial benefits through means such as delivering benefits, colluding with UIH personnel, privately inquiring about procurement information, or colluding with other suppliers to bid and squeeze out other suppliers.

6. Quality and Safety

The supplier, in providing its manufactured and sold goods or services, shall have the qualifications and capabilities that meet its production, operation, and service provision, strictly comply with laws and regulations, industry standards, and the requirements of the corresponding quality management system, and ensure that the goods or services provided meet the requirements for safeguarding personal and property safety.

7. Intellectual Property

The supplier shall comply with all applicable intellectual property laws and regulations, including but not limited to patent law, trademark law, copyright law, etc.

The supplier shall ensure that the goods, services, technology, or materials it provides do not infringe on any third party's intellectual property rights, including but not limited to patent rights, trademark rights, copyright, and trade secrets (collectively referred to as "intellectual property rights"), and take adequate measures, actions, and compensation to ensure that UIH does not suffer any loss when any third party claims rights due to the goods, services, technology, or materials provided by the supplier.

The supplier shall not infringe on the intellectual property rights of UIH and other UIH partners in any way at any time. If the supplier is aware of any unit or individual infringing on UIH's intellectual property rights (if any), it shall inform UIH of the relevant infringement situation in a timely, complete, and accurate manner.

The supplier acknowledges that the information generated, obtained, received, and retained by the supplier in the process of cooperating with UIH is UIH's confidential information, and this information will bring commercial benefits to UIH. For this information, the supplier will take adequate and reasonable measures to protect it to prevent the leakage, destruction, and unauthorized use of confidential information. The supplier shall not retain or use UIH's confidential information for purposes other than its cooperation with UIH, or after the termination of its cooperation with UIH. (Except as otherwise provided by law or agreed by both parties)

If UIH makes specific requests to the supplier in the process of realizing, obtaining, exercising, and protecting its intellectual property rights, the supplier shall provide support and cooperation.

8. Information Security and Privacy Data Protection

The supplier shall ensure that when collecting, using, processing, and storing personal information, it complies with applicable personal information protection laws and regulations and has a lawful basis for processing such personal information.

The supplier shall carefully limit the sharing of personal information with third parties and, before any such sharing, ensure that either the explicit consent of the data subject has been obtained or another lawful basis exists. The supplier shall also require such third parties to adhere to appropriate privacy protection requirements.

The supplier shall implement appropriate technical and organizational measures to safeguard information security and to ensure the confidentiality, security, integrity, and availability of information provided by UIH, its affiliates, as well as their employees, representatives, contractors, and suppliers (including but not limited to personal information, hereinafter referred to as "UIH Data"). These measures shall prevent unauthorized access, use, disclosure, modification, or destruction of UIH Data.

The information security measures to be adopted by the supplier shall include, but not be limited to, the following appropriate or necessary measures:

Access Control: Establish policies, procedures, and physical/technical controls; implement authentication protocols to ensure that only authorized personnel can access necessary information systems, physical areas, and data. When necessary, encrypt the media used for transmitting and storing UIH Data.

Information Security Awareness and Training: Provide regular security awareness and skill training to all employees, including management personnel.

Information Security Incident Management: Establish procedures for detecting, responding to, and resolving information security incidents, and document the process and results of such incidents. In the event of any security incident, vulnerability, threat, or similar situation that may affect UIH, the supplier shall immediately send a written notification to UIH via is@united-imaging.com and take

necessary measures to mitigate the negative impacts caused by the incident.

Continuity and Emergency Management: Adopt appropriate measures such as backup and recovery plans, and business continuity plans to ensure the availability and continuity of the technologies and services provided to UIH.

Device and Media Control: Implement protective measures for all devices and media that store UIH Data. Such protective measures shall include, but not be limited to, encryption, system security configuration hardening, and secure deletion and disposal procedures.

Meanwhile, the supplier shall be aware of UIH's information security management policies for suppliers and agree to undergo supplier information security risk assessment as required by UIH. UIH reserves the right to conduct ad-hoc reviews of the security of the systems used by the supplier to process UIH Data.

9. Supply Chain Security

The supplier is aware that the UIH has participated in various domestic and international supply chain security initiatives and programmes, including but not limited to AEO¹ programme, and supplier agrees to take security compliance measures required by the UIH and UIH's supply chain security system, to implement, record, monitor, evaluate, optimize and improve security management. The supplier shall ensure the legality, integrity and security of all products and services delivered to UIH. UIH has the right to audit the supplier's security procedures and equipment and facilities to ensure that the supplier meets the security compliance requirements of UIH and the supply chain security system.

10. Environmental Safety

The supplier shall protect the safety and health of its employees and other workers in the workplace. The supplier shall take preventive measures or provide protective equipment to protect the aforementioned personnel from harm and occupational diseases in the workplace.

The supplier shall clearly label and manage chemicals and other materials that may harm people or the environment, ensuring their safe handling, movement, storage, use, recycling, and reuse.

The supplier shall embrace the concepts of environmental protection and sustainable development, strengthen green supply chain management, enhance resource utilization efficiency, adopt effective energy-saving and environmental protection measures, and contribute to green and low-carbon development.

11. Labor and Human Rights

The supplier shall treat workers with respect and integrity, providing equal opportunities in recruitment, training, promotion, and other aspects, and avoiding any form of discrimination based on gender, age, race, nationality, religion, marital status, or other characteristics.

The supplier shall ensure that employees receive appropriate compensation and benefits, comply

with statutory working hours and rest periods, provide a safe working environment, establish effective communication channels, and offer adequate training and development opportunities.

The supplier shall comply with local laws and regulations, strictly prohibiting any form of forced labor and the use of child labor.

12. Cooperation in Auditing

For the supervision and audit of its activities related to its cooperation with UIH conducted by UIH, the supplier shall fully cooperate. To ensure that UIH's supervision and audit work is independent of other activities unrelated to UIH carried out by the supplier (if any), the supplier shall keep independent records and vouchers of its activities in cooperation with UIH (see Article 14 for more details).

13. Non-compliance Investigation

If a supplier becomes aware of any entity or individual engaging in any non-compliant behavior (including acts and omissions) while working for, cooperating with, or representing UIH, or discovers any corrupt practices or conflicts of interest between UIH personnel and the supplier, the supplier shall promptly, fully, and accurately report this to UIH via the UIH Compliance Hotline.

UIH reserves the right to investigate any potential violations of these guidelines by the supplier. In this regard, the supplier shall fully cooperate. If UIH requests the supplier's cooperation in investigating violations of UIH's rules and regulations by UIH personnel or other entities, the supplier shall provide full cooperation.

The supplier shall not take any retaliatory actions against any entity or individual who reports or discloses illegal or non-compliant situations to UIH.

14. Record Keeping

Supplier shall keep true, accurate, and complete records of their business activities related to their cooperation with UIH, including all information and materials that can be preserved and objectively reflect the facts, such as text, video, audio, computer data, etc., such as raw material purchase vouchers, production records, service records, supplier personnel employment contracts, job descriptions, etc.

Notes:

A. Compliance with this Code of Conduct for Supplier is a prerequisite for supplier to cooperate with UIH.

B. UIH reserves the right to revise the Code at any time in accordance with changes in laws, regulations, industry ethical standards, and related practices, and to notify Supplier. Supplier shall comply with the revised Code issued by UIH.

C. This Code takes effect from August 25, 2025.
